**Cridlin Food and Clothing Closet:** Each month for many years we have donated food to Cridlin. Now, we are being asked to give a little more. Lynn Cummings has agreed to a Pounding - a way to welcome newcomers with small pond gifts. WE aren't being asked to bring pound cake, but a wide list of other items. Since our first Pounding was more "an Ounce", we will continue the ingathering through June.

**Rise Against Hunger:** Our first Rise was a joyful success for First Church. On April 5, we left the building and joined other District churches at the Huntington Mall to fill food bags for hungry people. Nearly 100 First Church folks took part. This week, I learned that our food bags are headed to Ukraine.

**Flower Sale:** After much confusion, UWF got our flower order. We gained nearly \$400 for the mission work of women, children, and youth.

**Undie Sunday:** Once again we honored our Moms with undies. 276 pieces were contributed-179 went to Cridlin. 97 plus a dozen tooth brushes went to Ebenezer.

**COME/MIM:** On May 18, 9 Rivers District had an ingathering of money and goods for Ebenezer Outreach and Heart+Hand, South in S. Charleston. Our contribution was \$2300 from the Mission Grant Fund.

**Ebenezer Outreach**: Plans are complete and now we are working on publicity and fund raisers. If you know of any agencies who want to be involved in children's welfare, let Jane Morse know.
